Stages of competition	<p>Stage I</p> <p>The committee members evaluate the candidates according to the regulations adopted by the Faculty of History at the University of Warsaw. As a result of the vote, a short list of candidates admitted to stage II is created.</p> <p>Stage II</p> <p>In the second stage of the procedure, committee members evaluate candidates based on their achievements and interviews, creating a ranking of candidates, starting with the highest-rated candidate. Candidates receive points depending on their place in the ranking prepared by each committee member.</p>
